Established in 2007, the [Center for Narrative Research \(CNR\)](#) at the University of Wuppertal is home to a vibrant community of scholars from across the humanities and the social sciences. Every semester the Center's [Narratological Colloquium](#) offers PhD students, post-doctoral researchers and faculty an inspiring program comprising workshops, guest lectures and international lectures dedicated to a specific topic from the broad field of literary and non-literary narratives. Our colloquia have, for instance, focused on Popular Narratives, Football Narratives, Historical Narratology, and the Grammar of Narratives. Additionally, the Center's [Narrative Research Group](#) and our [Brown Bag Lunches](#) provide a collegial discussion forum for PhD students and postdoctoral researchers. Each year, the CNR hosts the world's only recurring [Lectureship on Factual Narratives](#), inviting distinguished intellectuals to share their thoughts on all things narrative.

The CNR is also known to an international community of researchers through its online journal [DIEGESIS](#). Established in 2012, DIEGESIS publishes two issues annually and is the first, and to date the only, open access journal for cross-disciplinary narrative research.
