



Paris-Oxford Partnership (POP) Results of the call for projects 2024

The PoP Evaluation Committee, composed by Université Paris Cité, CNRS, Institut des Etudes Avancées and Oxford University, announces the results of the CfP created to facilitate and strengthen scientific exchanges between Paris and Oxford for the year 2024. This call concerns all disciplines in the humanities and social sciences, with a preference for interdisciplinary projects. It is open to Visiting Fellows and Early Career Researchers from both institutions.

Applications

A total of 4 projects (3 Visiting Fellowships and 1 Early Career Researcher) were submitted by Université Paris Cité and a total of 2 projects (Visiting Fellowships) were submitted by Oxford University. The joint evaluation committee selected 5 projects and decided not to fund one project submitted by Université Paris Cité. The Oxford evaluators announced that the application was very interesting with a clear social impact, but that there was no host site in Oxford in the specific discipline.
